Your transcript from the LTHS counseling office; please request your 7-semester transcript 1-2 weeks prior to the LTEF deadline so that you can submit with your recommendation letters. If you did not have your SAT/ACT scores sent to LTHS, please include a printout of those scores as well.
Two (and no more than two) hand-signed letters of "professional" reference (non-relatives). The two letters must be delivered to the counseling office by 12:00 NOON on the deadline date. It is your responsibility to see that the letters are delivered by the deadline.

FINAL DEADLINE FOR ONLINE APPLICATION AND ALL SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION (TRANSCRIPT & LETTERS) TO BE NOTED ON LTEF WEBSITE.
